# All Saints/All Hallows, All Souls ...... A rich inheritance and an eternal reality!

This weekend we celebrate All Hallows, All Saints and All Souls. What can we learn from days that appear to speak of death rather than life? All Hallows' Eve is often misunderstood. It is the vigil of All Saints marking the beginning of the Triduum of All Hallowtide: a time in the liturgical year when we are to remember the dead, especially the saints, martyrs and the faithful departed believers. Humour is used to ridicule death and to defeat its power, but as Christians we believe in the one who gives life and victory over death.

The Gospel for All Saints is the account of the Sermon on the Mount. Christ presents us with the Beatitudes. Not only are some of these difficult to grasp but extremely challenging to live up to: what does it mean to be poor in spirit; to hunger and thirst for righteousness? It has been suggested that 'the Beatitudes demand to be discovered, and practised in day to day life, they are a spur to becoming a saint'. It is not a coincidence that 'Blessed' is a step toward sanctification and we have the very recent examples of Pope John Paul II, Pope John XXIII and Pope Paul VI. The memory of the saints inspires us to rise above the things of earth and to pray that Christ might reveal himself to us as he did to them. We are assured by St Paul that we are already part of God's household, and citizens like the saints, no longer aliens or foreigners. On the way to sainthood!

When I introduce palliative care to patients or carers I remind them that it is not about what we cannot do (prevent death) but it is about what we can do (provide support and comfort to the individual and their loved ones). Sainthood is about what with God's grace we can achieve.

We celebrated the feast of St Jude on Tuesday, the patron Saint of lost causes or hopeless cases. There are times when we may feel lost in faith or life but with this season in mind we are not lost in death. This season is one of hope. The Church in her wisdom gives us this living reality in death.

We read .... 'Think of the love that the Father has lavished on us, by letting us be **God's children and** that is what we are ..... and when it is revealed **we shall be like him** because we shall **see him as he really is.** Surely everyone who **entertains this hope must purify himself, must try to be as pure as Christ.**' (1 John 3:3)
