**STREET PASTORS THANK ALL WHO PRAY FOR THEM:**

1. Praise God for the improvements in the city centre over the 2 years we have been active. Praise God that this has enabled the police to reduce their numbers on Friday and Saturday nights as the level of violence dropped, notable in fewer arrests. More people are opening up to street pastors, sharing their pain and some are asking for prayer.
2. This change in the city is no doubt due to the regular prayer that goes on whilst the teams are on duty. Just as we need to recruit more street pastors each year, we need to recruit more people to pray each year as others have to stop praying due to changing family commitments. Please join us in praying for more people who are able to come and pray once a month on Fri or Sat. **THE NEW TRANSLATION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL – IS THE MASS CHANGING?** The structure of the Mass is not changing, nor are the actions of the Mass. The readings at Mass, which are often printed in Sunday and Weekday Missals, are not changing at this time, nor are the hymns we sing. However, with the introduction of the new translation from September, we will notice changes in what we say at Mass. A significant number of the texts have changed, sometimes by a few words, sometimes by much more. We will have to relearn prayers we used to pray from memory. Prayers said by the priest will also sound different. Musical settings which use the words of the Mass will change to reflect the new translation. The style of language we will hear and pray may seem more formal to us, and perhaps more complex. However, the new translation is a wonderful opportunity for us to 'hear again' texts with which we have become familiar, and perhaps discover new richness and meaning in them. **Yet even more to follow!**
