and to do it.

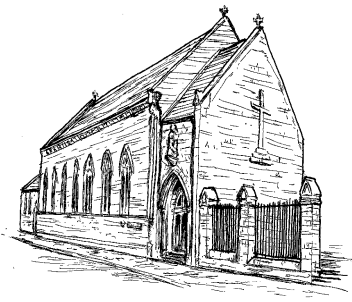

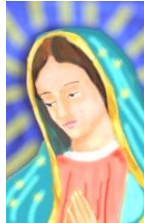
